A service to donors

Cambridgeshire Community Foundation (CCF) is an independent local charity which offers help, advice and professional management to individuals, families, local companies and public bodies that wish to support local charitable activities.

"We help donors to achieve their objectives and ensure they are as involved in the process as they wish to be"

Donors either contribute to an existing Fund or, with donations totalling £15,000 or more, set up their own "Named Fund".

A Named Fund works just like a charitable trust - but CCF han-

dles all the administration with the Charities Commission, claims for Gift Aid, the investment of your Fund and the trustee relationships for you. Named Funds can either be Endowed Funds, Annual Funds or a mixture of the two.

Endowed Named Fund

Money in an endowed fund is invested and each year a percentage set by the trustees (currently 5%) of the value of your Fund is available from which to make grants. You can either advise us how you wish the grant money to be applied for charitable purpose or tell us the sort of issues and geographies you want to support. We will bring selected re-

quests that we have reviewed and screened to you for your consideration and approval.

Annual Named Fund

An Annual Fund is used to make grants over a limited time period (typically 12-18 months) reducing the balance of the Fund to zero.
