**Cambridgeshire Community Foundation (CCF)** is an independent local charity which offers help, advice and professional management to individuals, families, local companies and public bodies that wish to support local charitable activities.

Much charitable activity in Cambridgeshire takes place away from the public eye. Cambridgeshire Community Foundation grants reach the smallest of local voluntary groups, those without professional fund-raisers, who have difficulty competing with national charities for necessary funds.

Our funds go to local voluntary groups for their work with people of

all ages and all aspects of social and community needs.

CCF helps donors to achieve their objectives and ensure they are as involved in the process as they wish to be.
