Grants will normally be offered in the range of £250* to £5,000, but larger grants are possible.

*Sponsorships, gifts and donations of less than £250

Sponsorships, gifts and grants of less than £250 are administered directly by Larkfleet Homes. The company recognises that many small groups, seeking small donations, may not be able to meet all the requirements of the Cambridgeshire Community Foundation's application process. Funded Projects

FoodCycle Peterborough received £5,000 towards the provision of a community meal where guests and volunteers can build friendships.

Young People March received £2,955 towards the provision of a Saturday open access session for 11 to 25 year-olds in March and the surrounding areas.

Made In Corby (Groundwork Northamptonshire) received £5,000 to to run a programme of arts workshops for older people to combat social isolation and promote good mental health and well-being.

Families First Peterborough CIC received £1,000 towards an arts and crafts workshop for young people and adults who are Care Leavers.
