The **maximum** allowance for **all** Street Aid grants is **£750**.

Grant money must be spent **within 2 months** of the money being received and receipts should be submitted to prove how the money has been used.

The fund has a limit of **one grant** per person in any **six-month** period and **two grants in total** per person
